Denise Malinowski Maxwell <input type="radio"/>	Tom Wencel <input type="radio"/>	<p>This millage will allow the school district to continue to levy not more than the statutory maximum rate of 18 mills on all property except principal residence and qualified agricultural property required for the school district to continue to receive its full revenue per pupil foundation allowance.</p> <p>Shall the limitation on the total amount of taxes which may be levied against all property in Dearborn Heights School District No. 7, County of Wayne, State of Michigan, be increased by and the board of education be authorized to levy not to exceed 3.0052 mills (\$3.0052 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) for a period of four (4) years, 2021 to 2024, inclusive, to provide in part the funds to operate and maintain the school system? This is a restoration of any Headlee Reduction through 2024.
